

## Where is the Irmo campus located?

The satellite campus will be located at 617 Koon Road. The site is at the corner of Koon Road and Broad River Road adjacent to I-26.



## What will be built on the site?

The Irmo campus will open in August of 2025 with 3 permanent modulars and an airnasium/weightroom. Construction will then continue with the addition of a permanent building in the future.



What grades will be served at the Irmo campus for the 2025-2026 school year? Grades 6-10. The school will expand to serving grades 6-12 at the Irmo campus.

## How can I apply to the West Columbia or Irmo campus?

Applications are available in the front office of the West Columbia campus at 3833 Leaphart Road for both sites. Applications are also available on the school's website under the "Admissions" tab. There is an application for each site.

#### Is the Irmo campus a separate school?

No, the Irmo campus is a satellite campus. It is an extension of Gray Collegiate Academy.

### When will I hear back about my child's acceptance?

Applications are reviewed on a continuous basis. It typically takes 3-4 weeks for applications to be reviewed from the time that they are submitted with all required documents.

## Is there an application to the West Columbia campus and the Irmo campus?

Yes. There is an application for each campus.

My child has already been accepted at the West Columbia campus for the 2025-2026 school year. Will I be given the option to have them switch to the Irmo campus? Yes, the Registrar's Office will reach out to all new students that have been accepted. These students will be given priority to opt to transfer to the Irmo campus based on the availability of courses.

## If I have already applied, will my child automatically be considered for the Irmo campus?

No. If your student has been waitlisted you will need to complete an application for the Irmo campus.

## Will current students be given the option to switch to the Irmo campus?

Yes, in February returning students' families complete the Letter of Intent. There will be a question where a family can note their desire for their student(s) to transfer to the Irmo campus. The transfer will be based on the availability of courses at the alternate campus.

### Will students be allowed to change campuses from year to year?

Yes, in February returning students' families complete the Letter of Intent. There will be a question where a family can note their desire for their student(s) to transfer to the Irmo campus. The transfer will be based on the availability of courses at the alternate campus.

## How many students are being accepted for the Irmo campus?

Approximately 600.

## Will there be a waitlist for accepted Irmo students who want to come to West Columbia if space opens up?

Yes, students who are accepted for the Irmo campus may join a waiting list for the West Columbia campus. Students will be able to transfer between campuses based on the availability of courses at the alternate campus.

I have a child who was accepted to the West Columbia campus and a sibling accepted later to the Irmo campus. Will we be given the option to move them to the same campus? Yes, if space is available at the alternate campus.

# If I have a 10th grader at the Irmo campus, will 11th grade be offered there the following school year?

Students who attend Irmo in the 10th grade will transfer to the West Columbia campus the following year for in-person instruction. There may also be synchronous options available for students to remain at the Irmo campus for their 11th grade year. The Irmo campus will expand to adding in-person instruction for 11th and 12th graders once all construction projects are completed.

## Will athletics remain at the West Columbia campus?

Yes, all athletic practices and events will take place at the West Columbia campus.

## Will there be transportation for athletes who cannot drive from the Irmo campus?

Yes, a shuttle will run from the Irmo campus to the West Columbia campus each afternoon for athletic practices. All students will need to be picked-up after athletic practices and events at the West Columbia campus.

## Can students take classes at both campuses?

Yes, there will be alternate course offerings at both campuses. If a student is able to provide transportation and the scheduling allows they will have the opportunity to take courses at both campuses.

## If I attend the Irmo campus where will my athletic district of residence be located?

Brookland-Cayce High School's attendance zone will continue to be Gray Collegiate Academy's district of residence.
